Dear Professor Drumm,


You will be aware of the ongoing concern among all the people of County Wexford at the possible outcome of the review group on acute hospital services in the South East.


This concern was most strongly voiced at a public meeting held in Wexford on September 27<sup>th</sup> last. Well over 1000 people filled the main conference room of White's Hotel and heard a first-hand account of the process from Dr. Colm Quigley (Clinical Director, Wexford General Hospital).


The eight Oireachtas members, all of whom attended and spoke at the public meeting, require that there be a democratic input into the review process. To this end we wish to request an urgent meeting with yourself as CEO of the Health Service Executive to hear our point of view.

We would greatly appreciate an early and positive response to this request.




